## PARK RULES

- Shear Barn Holiday park is a family-friendly holiday park that hosts accommodation for people from all walks of life: families with young and older children, couples, the older generation. Please make sure you are respectful to all during your time here. Any offensive behaviour that contravenes or causes danger to a customer or member of the team may result in us asking you to leave our site without reimbursement.
- Please act in a courteous and considerate manner towards other guests and the team- we ask that after 11pm noise levels are kept at a minimum as we consider this our quiet time.
- Children must be supervised at all times to ensure they are not a danger to themselves or others.
- Any visitors who are not booked to stay at our park must leave by 10pm.
- All vehicles must be driven carefully on the park and not exceed the displayed speed limit: 5mph on the touring field and 10mph on our main site.
- The party leader of each booking must be over the age of 21. We do not permit any bookings without a responsible adult over the age of 21 present and staying on our site.
- We do not allow smoking in any of our rental accommodation. If you are a smoker please dispose of your cigarettes responsibly in the bins dotted around the site.
- Be respectful-Please dispose of all litter in bins provided and leave pitches/ your rental accommodation clean and tidy for the next person when departing.
- When using the swimming pool, any weak swimmers or children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18+.
- Guns, firearms or offensive weapons including any imitation of weapons of any description are not permitted on the park.
- Any persons found to be under the influence of drugs or excessive alcohol and causing a problem will be asked to leave our site without reimbursement.
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times and not cause a nuisance to other guests, make sure you clean up any dog foul or a fine may be incurred.

## **Touring Field**

- Caravans & Motorhomes should be pitched according to instruction received at reception, you should not encroach onto surrounding pitches. If you require further assistance please speak to a member of the team prior to pitching up; if you have pitched incorrectly you may be required to move, especially during the height of the season when the park is busy.
- You are only permitted one car per pitch. Additional cars must go in the public car park next to Shear Barn. You are not permitted to put additional cars on vacant pitches
- Commercial or sign-written vehicles are not permitted on site.
- Fires and fire pits are prohibited.
