

## **PARK RULES - Please read before checking availability**

- **Twin axles, commercial vehicles, and sign-written vehicles are not permitted on site.**
- A **no-open-fire** policy is in effect. Anyone found violating this policy will receive one verbal warning and may be asked to leave the site.
- Caravans & Motorhomes should be pitched according to instructions received at reception; you must not encroach onto surrounding pitches. If you have pitched incorrectly, you may be required to move.
- Please act in a courteous and considerate manner towards other guests and the team. 11pm-8am is considered 'quiet time' across the park. Noise levels must be kept at a minimum during this time.
- Tent pitches are allowed a maximum of 2 vehicles (1 car is included in the price, a 2<sup>nd</sup> car is charged at £5). Caravan pitches are not permitted to have a 2<sup>nd</sup> car. Additional cars must go in the public car park next to the reception. You are not permitted to put additional cars on vacant pitches.
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
- Any visitors who are not booked to stay at our park must leave by 10pm.
- All vehicles must be driven carefully on the park and not exceed the displayed speed limit: 5mph on the touring field and 10mph on our main site.
- The party leader of each booking must be over the age of 21. We do not permit any bookings without a responsible adult over the age of 21 present and staying on our site.
- We do not allow smoking in any of our rental accommodation. If you are a smoker, please dispose of your cigarettes responsibly in the bins dotted around the site.
- Be respectful-Please dispose of all litter in bins provided and leave pitches/ your rental accommodation clean and tidy for the next person when departing.
- When using the swimming pool, weak swimmers and children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or over. For safety reasons, the required supervision ratio is one adult per two children under the age of 8.
- Guns, firearms, blades, or offensive weapons including any imitation weapons of any description are not permitted on the park.
- Any persons found to be under the influence of drugs or excessive alcohol and causing a problem will be asked to leave our site without reimbursement.
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times and not cause a nuisance. Uncleared dog fouling incurs £100 fine.

**Shear Barn Holiday Park is a family-friendly holiday park. Please make sure you are respectful to all during your time here. Any offensive behaviour that contravenes or causes danger to a guest or member of the team will result in us asking you to leave our site without reimbursement. For licencee's, failure to comply with the terms of your licence is grounds for termination of the licence agreement. This includes standards of courteous behaviour toward our holiday-makers.**
